

How to Farm Groundnut (Peanut)! Cultivation to Harvesting. A Comprehensive Guide

Ground nut production

A farmer should harvest ground nuts at 3.5 months and thresh and dry pods after harvesting and also filter to remove debris and put dry pods in bags and shell to separate seeds from pods. Put ground nuts seeds in bags and varieties of ground nuts include banada and kampala.

Similarly, Banada is early maturing at 3 months and 3 weeks while Kanapala take 4 months.
