

How to make compost; Easy and quick

The quality and quantity of compost manure is determined by the raw materials used in making the compost. Use of organic matter improves the quality and quantity of yield.

To make compost, green and brown materials are needed as green materials are high in nitrogen and wet. Fruit scraps are cut into small pieces to speed up the decomposition process. Brown materials are high in carbon and dry.

Making compost

In compost making, don't include plastics and hard wood. Use leaves mixed with fruit scrap and add soil to make compost. This is to make a thick layer on top of compost to prevent gnats from getting into it.

Similarly, add water to the compost to improve the decomposing process and after a few weeks, half decomposition is reached and air is allowed in the compost.

Remove top dry layer before mixing composting ingredients and mix well decomposing materials for uniformity. Add already decomposed material into fresh ones to speed up decomposition process. This is also left for another few weeks for decomposition.

Finally after 1-2 months, compost is ready for putting on crops. This improves crop growth and yield.
