

Kroiler Chicken farming part 1

Kroiler birds are native scavenging birds from India that can feed on a relatively wider range of feeds hence reducing costs.

Additionally, kroilers are highly demanded, resistant to both diseases and harsh environmental conditions and produces 150-200 eggs per year. Kroilers provide meat, eggs, employment opportunities and better incomes. It is highly recommended to allow birds to scavenge with supplementary kitchen feeds. Furthermore, well prepared Kroiler meat and eggs greatly improve family nutrition.

Practices involved

Ensure buying 2-3 weeks kroiler chicks that are fully vaccinated from a reputable supplier to reduce disease related mortalities.

Additionally, provide a secure clean shelter with enough space, always keep litter fresh and clean for birds to live well live in good conditions.

Furthermore, provide laying nests for easy laying and routine egg collection.

Lastly allow birds to scavenge as you provide supplementary feeds, keeping hygienic good shelter and periodically purchase new birds since kroilers yields reduce with time.

Generating incomes

Always allow birds to scavenge and provide birds with supplementary feeds as this helps to reduce feeding costs.

Also endeavour to sale kroiler chicken eggs and meat to cover production costs involved.

Lastly ensure collective kroiler marketing to facilitate proper market share, retention and continuity.
