Factors considered

Grass should also be considered before beginning goat farming. This can be planted as well supplemented with other crop residues. After harvesting corn, the remaining stovers can be converted into feed. Maize stovers in an acre can feed over 50 animals for 6 months. Elephant grass can also be used as a source of feed.

Water is essential in farming and should be considered before beginning goat farming.

Structures. These can be simple but technical and include spraying yard, exercising area, kids' pen and shelter for the goats. The dimensions depend on the number of goats you are rearing.

Genetics of the goats. Hybrids should be preferred compared to the locals because of the many advantages they have over the locals.
