

»Profitable Rabbit Farming in India«

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Rabbit farming is a different approach and change from the traditional cattle farming. It is being done all over the world and has created a space of business in the food and wool sector.

Like any other livestock business, rabbit farming also works the same way but with higher returns. In a short period of time you can start your extra income by developing proper knowledge on care and management of rabbits. Requirements

Start your business with a small point. Just take 25 to 30 rabbit kittens to start a small farm. The next requirement will be food and a shed for the rabbits for climatic and other protection values.

Keep the shed free from pests by cleaning it at regular intervals. Use antiseptic sprays and other similar medicines to keep the rabbits out of any diseases due to insects. Provide adequate supply of clean water to the rabbits throughout the day.

Care management

After setting up the farm, the rabbits should be taken care with utmost dedication. Half of the rabbit business fails as owners fail to take care of the animals and end up shutting the business.

Always understand that this business deals with living things and it is mandatory to check for their safety and health. If the rabbits are grown in a small farm, there is no need for a formal medical check up since they are under close

supervision.

Profits

Compared to other farms, rabbit farming is of low maintenance. Even if farming is carried out in large farms, the cost incurred is not so high since running it alongside other business is possible.

Rabbits give birth fast and this increases their numbers so even if you sell the rabbits every day, the number remains stable always and this guarantees you profits. The most important part of rabbit farming is proper feeding. Ensure nutrient rich greens, hay, cabbages, carrots and clean water is available always.
