Six best natural treats to eliminate bad smell in any poultry house

Poultry farm precautions

Following these precautions helps organic treats to work efficiently some of these precautions include, controlling water linkages in poultry houses to avoid the accumulation of moisture since accumulated moisture can cause the release of ammonia which causes a bad smell. Lastly, replace old litter so as to keep ammonia levels low.

Natural treatments

Start by adding vinegar to chicken water as well as spraying vinegar in chicken houses to lower uric acid levels as well as kill bacteria that cause bad smell respectively. Additionally, sprinkle either baking soda powder or biochar in the chicken coop to absorb moisture and neutralize odors. Furthermore, use pine wood shaving as poultry litter material and sprinkle diatomaceous earth in chicken houses to avoid moisture accumulation. Lastly, sprinkle lime in chicken houses, this cause faster elimination of ammonia gasses.
