

Strawberry Farm – Growing Strawberry Business Ideas with Low Investment and High Profit

The increased quality and quantity of strawberry production is highly determined by the level of technology used in the process.

Being a significant profitable soft fruit and easily grown, strawberry commercial farming is successful due to high demand and you gain huge earnings in a short period of time however early or late planting affects the yield.

Strawberry management

Given that plant bears red colour fruit berries, it is highly grown in colder regions and with proper agriculture techniques, one can increase the yield in the field. Get sufficient ploughing and plant either on flat or raised beds where plant depth must be very accurate and top portion of soil must remain outside.

Similarly, plant from September to October and during planting, seedlings are taken from nursery to field and planting is done at a spacing of 30*60 cm basing on variety and land type. Use mulching system to control weeds on farm and care for strawberry roots while using implements in weeding. Continue by use of honey bee colonies to pollinate flowers and irrigate newly planted crops frequently after planting.

Furthermore, apply organic matter to soil to improve water holding capacity of soil and protect the from from pests and diseases and finally when harvesting, harvest in the morning

and pick berries by stalks.
