

Training Video (Safe use of Pesticides)

Pesticide application

First, one should always read labels before using pesticides and in case of eye contact, call doctor for treatment and don't induce vomiting and as well rinse the eyes with water for 15-20 minutes in case of eye contact. Move the person to fresh air if pesticide is inhaled or give artificial respiration.

Similarly, use buffer zones always when using pesticides and be fully covered when using them and always wash the protective gears separately. Test application rate of equipment, monitor site conditions, post buffer zones and create emergency response plan.

Be prepared for spills, routinely inspect containers, rinse them repeatedly remove paper label and return clean containers for recycling and finally always keep pesticide records which involve the date of application and the pesticide applied.
